FEMA Funding May be Available – Apply by May 8, 2024!

Several residents of Hamtramck have already applied for FEMA Disaster Assistance and received grant money that does not need to be repaid due to the storm event.

For needs not covered by insurance and other sources, FEMA may be able to provide Individual Assistance grant money that does not have to be repaid for:

**Rental assistance if you need to relocate because of storm damage*

**Personal property that was damaged or destroyed by the storms*

**Basic home repairs for homeowners whose primary residence was damaged by the storms*
