School District of the City of Hamtramck Operating Millage Replacement Proposal		
<p>This tax levy does not apply to owner occupied homes or to persons renting their homes. This proposal would replace and extend the authority of the School District to continue to levy the statutory limit of 18 mills on all property, except principal residences (owner occupied homes) and other property exempt by law, for general operating purposes, which currently expires with the School District's 2025 tax levy and allow the School District to continue to levy the statutory limit of 18 mills in the event of future Headlee rollbacks of up to 2 mills. This authorization will allow the School District to continue to receive revenues at the full per pupil foundation allowance permitted by the State.</p> <p>Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residences and other property exempted by law, situated within the School District of the City of Hamtramck, County of Wayne, Michigan, be increased in the amount of 20 mills with 18 mills being the maximum allowable annual levy (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a period often (10) years, 2025 to 2034, inclusive? This operating millage if approved and levied, would provide estimated revenues to the School District of \$2,748,420 during the 2025 calendar year, to be used for general operating purposes.</p>
