The City of Hamtramck has an opening for a full-time Sewer Laborer in our Department of Public Service Department located in City Hall 3401 Evaline Hamtramck, MI 48212. This is an AFSCME union position and reports to the DPS foreman. Work hours are Monday through Friday 6:00am-4:00pm alternating four (4) ten (10) hour days.

Job Description Summary:

Under the general supervision of the Department of Public Services supervisors, with direct guidance from the senior sewer division employees, provides general labor in support or a wide range of maintenance projects, and other duties/tasks as assigned.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform equipment pre/post trip inspections and minor maintenance
- Determine necessary supplies for the daily operation of the sewer cleaning truck
- Operating industrial vacuum trucks and hydro; blasting equipment
- Assist with loading, unloading, setup and teardown of equipment; industrial vacuum hose, hydro-blast hoes
- Load and prepare equipment for jobs
- Set-up and operate sewer cleaning equipment
- Operate several handheld and operated equipment
- Conduct internal sewer line cleaning and inspections
- Place traffic cones and other barricades at job sites
- Identify line sections to be inspected with the use of maps
- Threads cable through sewer lines and places camera inside manholes to televise sewer line
- Operates and adjust camera controls to obtain optimum clarity and contrast
- Prepares description of each sewer defect and records pertinent data
- Operates mobile sewer cleaning equipment and television equipment to conduct internal sewer line cleaning and inspections
- Inspect waste related paperwork manifests, bills of lading, and land disposal restriction forms for accuracy and completeness before transport; ensure proper placarding

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Ability to perform manual labor; digging, pushing, lifting, twisting, turning upper body, stooping, kneeling, crouching, climbing, reaching for objects, walking/standing
- Ability to work in adverse weather conditions for prolonged periods of time
- Ability to lift/carry items/equipment weighing 50 pounds
- Meet deadlines and the ability to quickly change work priorities
- Excellent written and oral communication
- Ability to work independently
- Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions, including proper lifting techniques.
